

# Happy Trails Riding Academy

## 2015 Annual Report

As Happy Trails celebrated its 31st year of providing physical, cognitive, and psychological-social benefits to children and adults with disabilities from the California San Joaquin Valley, we continued to expand our services, strengthen our collaborations, and develop our property as one of the premier Equine Assisted Activity and Therapy (EAAT) centers in the country.

In 2015 Happy Trails was one of the few therapeutic riding programs in the nation to offer *Therapeutic Horsemanship*, *EFP/EFL* (Equine Facilitated Psychotherapy/Learning), *Equine Activities and Therapy* with an occupational therapist, *Interactive Vaulting Cart Driving*, and *Equine Services for Heroes*.

*Equine Assisted Activities and Therapy* has many advantages over traditional therapy and treatment. Some of the physical health benefits include: increased balance, strength and flexibility, stretching of tight or spastic muscles, increased range of motion of the joints, and reduction of abnormal movement. Psychological benefits include: improved self-confidence, increased interest in the outside world, increased interest in one's own life, development of patience, emotional control, self-discipline, sense of normality, and expansion of the focus of control. Social benefits include: friendship, increased experiences, and enjoyment. Other benefits of EAAT activities include the ability to process information, improved language skills, independence and self-confidence.

We were extremely pleased in 2015 to continue our partnership with *PATH, International* and the *Wounded Warrior Project* in offering our services to military veterans. The Equine Services for Heroes program aims to create confident, consistent, dependable, quiet horsemen and horsewomen who are developing a trusting relationship with a horse, and hopefully, taking and applying these lessons to their everyday lives. Our goal in 2016 is to expand this program to all interested veterans with a VA grant we received.

For the 11th consecutive year we increased the number of rides offered to our children and adults with disabilities. In 2015 we provided 2,394 lessons to 138 riders from 16 Central Valley communities: Tulare, Visalia, Hanford, Porterville, Lindsay, Exeter, Dinuba, Lemoore, Woodlake, Farmersville, Springville, Earlimart, Tipton, Orosi, Sultana and Fresno. The 138 riders ranged in

age from 4 to 50+, with the majority (90%) under the age of 18. Our riders are challenged by a variety of disabilities including ADHD, developmental delay, autism, cerebral palsy, Down Syndrome, fetal alcohol affects and various psychological-social issues.

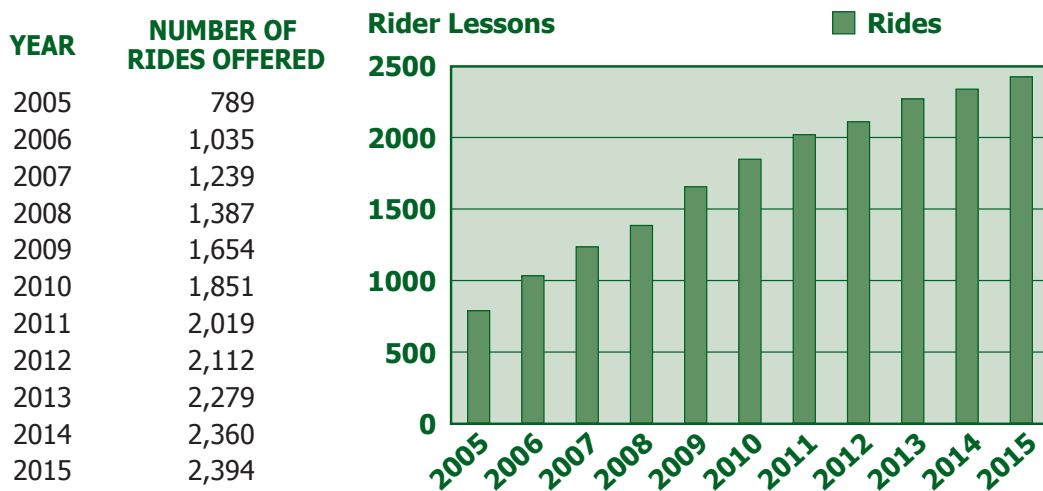


We continued our successful collaboration with *Tulare County Health and Human Services* and *Tulare Youth Service Bureau* to provide EFP/EFL services to youth in the community, including many in the foster care system. The mental health professionals and their clients find Happy Trails a nurturing and peaceful environment where the kids can be successful and their equine partners allow them to open up.

In May, the Happy Trails team entered four riders in the CALNET Horseshow held at the *Los Angeles Equestrian Center*. The show attracted more than 90 disabled athletes from over a dozen therapeutic riding centers. Our riders competed in obstacles, pole bending, equitation and showmanship. Each rider brought home at least one first place ribbon, and our

staff and volunteers were repeatedly complimented on their professionalism. Jenny Wong was the *Overall Walk Trot High Individual* and Clifford Evans was the recipient of the prestigious *2015 Chris Ludwig Award for Excellence in Sportsmanship and Effort*.

The development of the front 10 acres is complete! Thanks to generous donations from *Visalia Community Rotary Foundation*, *The Fansler Foundation*, *Saputo Dairy Products*, *G for Kids*, and *The*

the drilling of a new well. By the end of September *Loverin Well & Pump* completed drilling a 416-foot well (the existing well was 187 feet deep). The new well was developed and the water is flowing. The price tag for this project was \$68,637.08. We did not have to pull from our operational reserves to pay this bill thanks to the generous donations of many in the community, especially *Lance & Jamie Mouw*, *The Law Offices of Douglas L. Hurt*, *The Sence Foundation*, *United Way of Tulare County* and the *City of Visalia*.

On May 29, 2015 we hosted our most successful fundraising event of the year, *Night at the Races*, at the Visalia Convention Center. Thanks to our many sponsors, prize donors and attendees, we raised just under \$100,000.

On October 2, 2015, we hosted the annual *Round Up* on our property. Over 400 people attended the event which included a wine raffle, a wonderful dinner, and entertainment.

*Sence Foundation*, funds were secured for the completion of the 10 acre expansion project. The project included a driving path, two additional permanent pastures, and a 150'x 300' outdoor riding arena. The community support is, once again, helping Happy Trails grow to impact more lives. This expansion allows the horses more room to roam, which will ensure happier and healthier equines and also cut down on our hay costs. The completion of the driving path allows trail rides along the perimeter of the property, as well as cart driving on the same path. The additional arena allows for more classes to be offered.

In addition to the development of our front 10 acres, we were faced with water issues, like many others in the valley. First, our agricultural well began experiencing difficulties with the water flow in mid-July. A 20 hp submersible pump and new electrical panel were installed and we were able to resume irrigation without problem. Greg Loverin with *Loverin Well & Pump* donated almost half the cost, leaving a bill for \$9,000.

In early August our domestic well had no pressure and tests revealed the pump was sitting in only a few feet of water. This necessitated

We were also able to continue our popular *Adopt a Rider* (\$2,500), *Adopt a Horse* (\$1,000), *Adopt a Class* (\$500), and *Adopt a Ride* (\$25) programs with support from donations and pledges. This annual pledge program continues to grow and provides an additional and important revenue stream.

Our fundraising was flanked by several smaller events that included *Tulare County Motorcycle Ride*, *Harley-Davidson Poker Run*, *Autism Awareness Walk*, *Tulare County Young Professional mixer*, *Workout for a Cause*, and the *Country Club Mortgage* holiday party. We are extremely grateful and appreciative to the community groups who have included us in their fund raising efforts.

Happy Trails is once again in a healthy fiscal position. A renewed emphasis on fund raising and the money generated from the EFP contract, along with riding fees and other community support, allowed Happy Trails to meet its budget of \$410,000 this year. The approved budget for 2015-2016 is set at \$445,000.

There was more than 10,754 hours volunteer hours expended this year in arena classes and property improvement projects. Plans for 2016 call for continued operations of our existing programs. We expect to keep our upward projection for classes offered, which represents a steady, responsible increase each year. We are also undertaking the development and construction of a hay barn and storage facility.

As the only Premiere Accredited Therapeutic Riding Program between Bakersfield and Modesto we will continue to provide excellent service to the children and adults with disabilities in our communities.
